Massage Program Timetables

Massage qualifications are gained by completing a set number of 'modules' in a qualification. These modules can be timetabled at different times throughout the seven day week between 8.15am to 9.30pm. The following timetable information includes:

- Summary of the modules required to complete a qualification
- Sample timetables outlining the days and times these modules are typically scheduled

Timetable and schedule of classes are set by the School

Students will average between 15 to 20 hours of on-campus study per week plus home study.

Due to the variety of modules needed for each massage qualification, your timetable will vary from one term to the next. A student's term timetable is determined by the School and sent to the student via email before the commencement of each new term. Students should expect a different timetable every term.

Check your availability against sample timetables before you enrol

Students should refer to the sample timetables provided as an indication how and when the different course modules are scheduled. Whilst these may be subject to change they are fairly indicative of the type of timetable the student can expect and hence for you to ensure you can commit to going forward.
